## TOWN OF LAND O' LAKES AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF DOGS #96-3

The Town Board of the Town of Land O' Lakes, Vilas County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. DOG RUNNING AT LARGE. A dog is considered to be running at large if it is off the premises of its owner and not under the control of the owner or some other person.

<u>Section 2.</u> UNTAGGED DOG. A dog is considered to be untagged if a valid license tag is not attached to a collar which is kept on the dog whenever the dog is outdoors unless the dog is securely confined in a fenced area.

Section 3. DOG RUNNING AT LARGE OR UNTAGGED DOG SUBJECT TO IMPOUNDMENT. An officer or a designated employee of the town shall attempt to capture and restrain any dog running at large and any untagged dog.

Section 4. PENALTIES. If the owner of a dog negligently or otherwise permits the dog to run at large or be untagged, the owner shall forfeit not less than \$25. nor more than \$100. for the first offense and not less than \$50. nor more than \$200. for subsequent offenses.

Section 5. Any dog found running at large in violation of the regulations herein enacted shall be impounded at the owners expense and the town officials may proceed as in Section 174 of the Wisconsin Statutes;
